"WE SERVE" Business Meeting Minutes for 8 NOV 2023

Meeting Location: Messiah Lutheran Church's Celebration Hall 5600 Old Washington Road Sykesville MD 21784

Meeting was called to order: at 6:29 p.m. by President Lion Melissa Turski with a welcome to everyone.

Attendance Total: 50 (Members – 45 / Guests -5). A list of the attendees is included at the end of these meeting minutes.

Opening Ceremonies:

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Lion Gilbert Fleming. Song "God Bless America" was led by Lion Kelsey Hof. Invocation was offered by Club Co-Chaplain Lion Bob Bastress. Lions Toast was led by Lion John Dozsa.

Dinner was catered by Bullock's Restaurant. Dinner was chosen for it being diabetes friendly. It was roasted chicken, parslied potatoes, green beans, tossed salad, fruit, and unsweetened cookies.

Meeting Reconvenes: The meeting resumed after dinner at 7:10pm with President Lion Melissa Turski thanking members of the FDLC Meals Committee for their help serving the dinner. Lion Melissa Turski introduced PDG Evan Gillett and his wife Bonnie. Lion Don Champ introduced a new potential member David Wolff attending tonight's meeting.

Program Speaker was introduced by Lion Tony Ramirez. Amy Michael is the Coordinator for Diabetes Awareness at Carroll Hospital.

Program As this is Diabetes Awareness Month, it was appropriate that Amy gave us a tutorial about Diabetes called "Diabetes and Pre-diabetes and What You Need to Know."

*Some stats from 2022. 96 Million U.S. Adults are Pre-Diabetic. 9.8% of Carroll County population is diabetic.

*A daily blood sugar of 100-125 or an A1C of 5.7-6.4 is considered to be Pre-Diabetic, More than 126 or A1C higher than 6.5 is considered Diabetic.

*Pre-Diabetes is reversible, Diabetes is not.

* Recommended intake of sugar is less than 22 grams of added sugar /day (three packs of sugar)

*Some Risk Factors for Diabetes: age over 45, overweight, not physically active three times a week, high blood pressure, high cholesterol

*Some Symptoms of Diabetes: less energetic, thirsty, dry mouth, dry skin, numbness in hands and feet, and slow healing.

*Here are some ways to lower your A1C: Insulin doses, exercise, lose weight, avoid sugary drinks, eat your vegetables, lower your stress, and eat more fiber.
