• One-Time Projects:

 Protective Face Shields – preparing & delivering over 1,200 face shields to local nursing homes, health agencies, hospital & hospices during the onset of the pandemic

- Pop-Up Food Pantry in May 2020, operated a pop-up food pantry each Sunday for over 20 weeks. This project served 105-180 people (35-60 families/cars) weekly by distributing free milk, eggs, bread, fresh vegetables, and other groceries
- Heroes Project In 2021&2022, members prepared and delivered "thank you" bags containing travel mugs, drinks, snacks, & other items to over 600 members or the staff at Carroll Hospital and local First Responders

• Preschool Vision Screening
