### Membership Requirements:

The requirements to be a regular (active) member of the Freedom District Lions Club, Inc. can be summarized as follows :

- Must be of legal majority age (18 or older)
- Reflects a standard off good and ethical conduct in the community as a representative of the Freedom District Lions Club Inc, and Lions Club International
- Pays all dues, meals, and other monetary obligations owed to the club in a timely manner
- Supports at least two (2) club service projects and two club fundraisers each year
- Serves on at least one club committee each year
- Attends at least two (2) business meetings during a normal July-June (12 months) Lions business year except when excused due to health, advanced age, employment, or other legitimate personal reasons
- Notifies the Club Secretary in advance (five days) by email or phone when bringing guest(s) to a club dinner meeting

The annual dues (Line 4 above) are billed on a quarterly basis via email and are used to cover approved Administrative operating expenses at each organizational level.

Lions who qualify in the categories below will pay only one-half of Lions Club International Dues (\$46.00) = \$23.00 annually.

Family Plan: the second, third, fourth, and fifth members who are related to the first member and live at the Same address.

Student Plan : any Lion who is attending college and is between ages of 18 to 24.

Leo to Lion Program : Leos who reach the age of 18 can join with the payment of no entrance fee and half LCI dues up until age 30.

### **Dinner Meetings :**

Dinner Meals at FDLC Business Meetings happen every month on the Second Wednesday. The cost varies depending on the caterer's service, and is always communicated via e-mail by the Club Secretary. There are approximately 14 business meetings per year. Members must notify the Club Secretary by Saturday prior to the business meeting if they will be having dinner, so that a meal count can be provided to the caterer.
